



Upgrade to TAE40116 Certificate IV in Training & Assessment Information Pack

The National VET Regulator (ASQA) has mandated all current holders of TAE40110 must also hold additional units of competency by the 1st of July 2019. Anyone who does not meet this requirement by 1st of July 2019 will no longer be able to deliver nationally recognised training and assessment in Australia.

This information pack explains what is required and what you may need to do to remain compliant with this ASQA requirement.

TAE40116 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment

This qualification requires 10 units of competency, consisting of 9 Core units and 1 Elective. Our standard program is:

Core Units:

TAEASS401 Plan assessment activities and processes

TAEASS402 Assess competence

TAEASS403 Participate in assessment validation

TAEASS502 Design and develop assessment tools

TAEDEL401 Plan, organise and deliver group-based learning

TAEDEL402 Plan, organise and facilitate learning in the workplace

TAEDES401 Design and develop learning programs

TAEDES402 Use training packages and accredited courses to meet client needs

TAELLN411 Address adult language, literacy and numeracy skills

Elective Units (one only required)

TAEASS301 Contribute to assessment

TAEDEL301 Provide work skill instruction

BSBCMM401 Make a presentation

How do you know what you need?

Check the units of competency listed on your TAE40110 Cert IV TAE.

Do all the core units listed above appear your certificate?

If **Yes**, great and you just need to upgrade TAEASS401 and TAEASS403 and then we can credit transfer across to the new TAE40116 Cert IV in Training and Assessment if you wish.



If **No**, then you need to complete the missing units of competencies, upgrade TAEASS401 and TAEASS403 and then we can credit transfer you across to the new TAE40116

Once you have completed the necessary units of competency you are then ASQA compliant.

You can simply hold them as a separate statement of attainment, or you can request a full credit transfer over to the new TAE40116 Cert IV in Training and Assessment. It's your choice.

What are most people having to do?

Most people need to complete the **TAEASS502 Design and develop assessment tools unit of competency**.

Some people also need to complete **TAELLN411 Address adult language, literacy and numeracy skills**

Note: If you hold the TAELLN401A this can be accepted instead of the TAELLN411

We will check it out and let you know what your situation is totally obligation free.

TAEASS401 & TAEASS403

We also need to cover off the TAEASS401 & TAEASS403 units. Neither of these units are 100% direct equivalents to their predecessor units.

Do we have RPL kits for these units?

Most people are able upgrade these two (2) units by completing the two small RPL processes.

Occasionally, in some cases, it may be a simpler process to complete the entire units from the beginning. Please feel free to discuss these options with us.
